Remember there's no better time than Valentines Day to tell your special loved one just how special they are and you can do this with the perfect bouquet, incorporating your own personalised message.

Communications Manager for Sydney Markets Limited, Retina Hong, says the top selling flower is still the rose, and the quality and variety of colours available in the Sydney Flower Market is sensational this time of year.

"In the lead up to Valentines Day, it's interesting to note the increase in the number of consumers looking to send flowers with a long vase life, and have opted to send oriental lilies, lisianthus, chrysanthemums, Australian natives and tropicals, including the strelitzia, heliconias, crab claws and ginger flowers," said Retina.

Valentines Day is one of the two most important events on the flower growers calendar, the other being Mothers Day. For growers, wholesalers and florists the lead-up to Valentines Day is almost as busy as the big day itself.

On Valentines Day, florists will shop at the Sydney Flower Market between 5am and 11am so it's really important that consumers, if they haven't already done so, get their orders in with their local florist – that way they will be able to organise an individual, unique arrangement for their Valentine. Of course, most florists will still have last minute bunches available for last minute purchases or for those who have forgotten!

Ordering prior to Valentines Day also means that growers and florists know the varieties and quantities of flowers to supply and buy in advance, alleviating some of the pressure on the 14<sup>th</sup>.

The Sydney Flower Market is the key Wholesale Market for fresh cut flowers in NSW and the largest of its kind in Australia. It is estimated that the Sydney Flower Market has an annual turnover in excess of \$150 million and accounts for approximately 75% of the wholesale cut flower trade in NSW. Potted plants and florist supplies such as ribbon, wrap, foam and other sundries are also sold.
