# Pedestrian Safety

SML reminds all stakeholders of the importance of always using pedestrian access ways and crossings. All stakeholders have a Work Health and Safety (WHS) responsibility and obligation to their workers and visitors to the Market.

Although not exhaustive, the following information is provided to assist stakeholders to comply with their WHS requirements.

- **Be alert when in the Markets; be aware of your surroundings and avoid distractions such as talking on a mobile phone**
- **Always wear a Hi-Vis safety vest**
- **Always use and stay in walkways**
- **Always use pedestrian crossings**
- **Be aware that pedestrians are not always visible to forklift operators and should exercise caution**

In the interest of safety, all vehicles must give way to pedestrians at all pedestrian walkways/access ways.
